2207/5 **Report from Ward Councillors**

Resolved: That the council unanimously agreed to temporarily suspend the meeting to receive the ward councillors report

Ward Cllr Hannigan updated the meeting regarding the progress of a public toilet and was agreed for the council to discuss at the next full council meeting. The next round of Green Homes heating grants have become available for families on low incomes and can be applied for through the North Lincolnshire Council website.

Council tax rebates are being processed and households that pay by direct debit should be complete. Freight transport program for North Lincolnshire Council is still ongoing and NLC Highways department are in communications regarding the Carbon Capture Project prior to reaching the planning stage.

Cllr Wells informed the parish council they are to make contact with carbon project and asked for parishioners to be vigilant if landowners are approached regarding their land.

Howe Lane is now complete, however complaints of the drains that are now blocked with rubble and tarmac have been received. Ward Councillors to chase the already reported issue.

Proposed bus shelter is still being investigated between the Clerk and Transport Department at NLC
